The **Door Display** sits at the entranceway to the L&D room. It provides room status and key information about the patient. Caregivers will know which staff may be in the room and are caring for the patient. Staff can also video conference into the room from the Door Display

## FOR MOM & BABY

- Antepartum care data for mother such as dilation and for baby such as heart rate are provided.
- Post-delivery, the Whiteboards display newborn care data, recovery tips, and follow-up appointments.
- Displaying progression, planned check-ups, and procedures is critical information for both mom and family.

## FOR CAREGIVERS

- Integrations into the EMR and other systems keep the boards updated automatically - no input required of caregivers.
- Information about progress of delivery and who is on the care team help staff get up to speed quickly.
- The Door Displays provide caregivers critical information before entering the room.
